- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12

- 17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "ELECTRONIC MAIL" MEANS A COMMUNICATION OR
- 18 MESSAGE SENT TO A SPECIFIC PERSON OR PERSONS THROUGH THE USE OF A
- 19 COMPUTER AND INTENDED TO BE RECEIVED BY A COMPUTER.
- 20 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT USE ELECTRONIC MAIL:
- FOR AN ANONYMOUS COMMUNICATION IF IN A MANNER 21 (1)
- 22 REASONABLY TO BE EXPECTED TO ANNOY, ABUSE, TORMENT, HARASS, OR
- 23 EMBARRASS ONE OR MORE PERSONS:
- FOR REPEATED COMMUNICATIONS, IF WITH INTENT TO ANNOY,
- 25 ABUSE, TORMENT, HARASS, OR EMBARRASS ONE OR MORE PERSONS; OR

- 1 (3) FOR ANY COMMENT, REQUEST, SUGGESTION, OR PROPOSAL WHICH
- 2 IS OBSCENE, LEWD, LASCIVIOUS, FILTHY, OR INDECENT, IF WITH INTENT TO ANNOY,
- 3 ABUSE, TORMENT, HARASS, OR EMBARRASS ONE OR MORE PERSONS.
- 4 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
- 5 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500 OR TO
- 6 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 3 YEARS OR BOTH.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 8 October 1, 1998.
