	CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt - Harford County - The Ripken Stadium

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$3,000,000
- \$200,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Mayor and City Council of
- 5 the City of Aberdeen for certain acquisition, development, or improvement
- 6 purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a
- 7 requirement that the grantee <u>provide a certain letter to the Board of Public</u>
- 8 Works and provide and expend a matching fund; and providing generally for the
- 9 issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11 MARYLAND, That:

- 12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Harford
- 14 County The Ripken Stadium Loan of 1998 in a total principal amount equal to the
- 15 lesser of (i) \$3,000,000 \$200,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in
- 16 accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale,
- 17 and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board
- 18 of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through
- 19 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 20 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as 21 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 22 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 23 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 24 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 25 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then

- 1 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 2 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 3 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Mayor and City Council of the City of
- 4 Aberdeen (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the planning, design,
- 5 construction, and capital equipping planning and design of a new baseball stadium in
- 6 the City of Aberdeen in Harford County, to be named The Ripken Stadium in honor of
- 7 the Ripken family, so famous and respected in professional baseball and so long
- 8 associated with the Baltimore Orioles, with Cal Ripken, Sr. as manager and coach,
- 9 Billy Ripken as second baseman, and Cal Ripken, Jr. as shortstop and third baseman.
- 10 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 11 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 12 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 13 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 14 (5) (a) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for
- 15 the purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee and the County Executive
- 16 and County Council of Harford County shall the following shall occur:
- 17 (i) The grantee and the County Executive and the County Council
- 18 of Harford County shall provide a joint letter of commitment to the Board of Public
- 19 Works stating the intent of the grantee to provide \$900,000 and the intent of the
- 20 County Executive and County Council of Harford County to provide \$1,900,000 as a
- 21 grant to the City of Aberdeen of which all funds shall be pledged toward the costs of
- 22 constructing and equipping a new baseball stadium in the City of Aberdeen in
- 23 Harford County, to be named The Ripken Stadium;
- 24 (ii) The Mayor and City Council of Aberdeen shall have a contract
- 25 with a minor league baseball team to play baseball at the new stadium; and
- 26 (iii) The grantee and the County Executive and the County Council
- 27 of Harford County shall provide and expend a matching fund. Of the total amount of
- 28 the matching fund, the grantee is responsible for \$1,000,000 \$100,000 and the County
- 29 Executive and County Council of Harford County are responsible for \$2,000,000
- 30 \$100,000. No part of the matching fund may consist of funds that have been acquired,
- 31 either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 32 unappropriated. No part of the matching fund may consist of real property, in kind
- 33 contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any
- 34 dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify
- 35 as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the
- 36 Board's decision is final. The grantee and the County Executive and County Council
- 37 of Harford County have until September 1, 1998, to present evidence satisfactory to
- 38 the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided.
- 39 (b) If satisfactory evidence is presented that the requirements of
- 40 paragraph (a) of this subsection have been met, the Board shall certify this fact these
- 41 facts and the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of
- 42 the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes
- 43 provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching

- $1\,$ fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further $2\,$ effect.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 June 1, 1998.
