11 (a) If the required security for any vehicle terminates or otherwise lapses at 12 any time, the registration of that vehicle:					
13	(1) Is suspended automatically as of the date of termination or lapse; and

22	(1) In a traffic citation issued to the person under this subtitle; or

31	(a) If a person fails to comply with a notice to appear in U.S. District Court contained in a traffic citation issued to him under federal traffic laws or regulations for a violation occurring in Maryland, the U.S. District Court may notify the Administration of the noncompliance.				

- 1 (b) On receipt of a notice of noncompliance from the U.S. District Court, and 2 after giving the person 10 days' written notice, the Administration may suspend the 3 driving privileges of the person.
- 4 (c) With the cooperation of the U.S. District Court, the Administration shall 5 develop procedures to carry out the provisions of this section that relate to the 6 suspension of driving privileges.

- 8 (h) Any person who is convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of § 9 15-502(a) of this article ("License required"), § 16-303[(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), or (g)]
- 10 of this article ("Driving while license is canceled, suspended, refused, or revoked"), §
- 11 17-107 of this article ("Prohibitions"), or § 17-110 of this article ("Providing false
- 12 evidence of required security") is subject to:
- 13 (1) For a first offense, a fine of not more than \$1,000, or imprisonment 14 for not more than 1 year, or both; and
- 15 (2) For any subsequent offense, a fine of not more than \$1,000, or 16 imprisonment for not more than 2 years, or both.

- 18 (a) If a person fined under the Maryland Vehicle Law or under any federal
- 19 traffic law or regulation for a violation occurring in Maryland does not pay the fine in
- 20 accordance with the court's directive:
- 21 (1) The court may so certify to the Administration; and
- 22 On such certification, after giving the person 10 days advance
- 23 written notice, the Administration may suspend the driving privileges or license of
- 24 the person until the fine has been paid.
- 25 (b) With the cooperation of the District Court and the U. S. District Court, the
- 26 Administration shall develop procedures to carry out the provisions of this section.
