1 WHENEVER WHEN THE ADMINISTRATION ASSESSES A PRORATED (6)2 FEE IS ASSESSED, THE AMOUNT, IT SHALL BE CALCULATED BY MULTIPLYING 3 ONE-TWELFTH OF THE APPLICABLE FEE BY THE NUMBER OF MONTHS FOR WHICH 4 THE ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL IS MADE AND THE RESULTANT FIGURE SHALL BE 5 ADJUSTED ADJUSTING THIS AMOUNT TO THE NEAREST DOLLAR AMOUNT. THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT AND 6 OPERATE A STAGGERED REGISTRATION SYSTEM AS PROVIDED UNDER THIS 8 SECTION. 9 13-912. 10 When registered with the Administration, every passenger car and station 11 wagon, except as otherwise provided in this part, is a Class A (passenger) vehicle. 12 (b) For each Class A (passenger) vehicle, the annual registration fee is: 13 For a vehicle with a manufacturer's shipping weight of 3,700 pounds (1) 14 or less -- \$27.00; and 15 For a vehicle with a manufacturer's shipping weight of more than 16 3,700 pounds -- \$40.50. 17 Notwithstanding any provision of this subtitle to the contrary, the 18 Administration may adopt a system of staggered registration for the following motor 19 vehicle classes: A, B, C, D, E (up to 7,000 pounds maximum gross vehicle weight), J, 20 L, 1A (dealer), 1B (motorcycle dealer), 1C (trailer dealer), 2 (recycler), 3 (finance 21 company), 4 (mobile equipment), 5 (transporter), and M. 22 During the registration period in which the system is initiated, (d) (1) 23 vehicle registrations may be issued for periods varying from 7 months to 18 months 24 with fees prorated according to the number of months for which the registration is 25 issued. 26 Vehicle registration plates or validation tabs shall be issued and 27 displayed in accordance with a schedule established by the Administrator. Any new registration or renewal issued during the year may be 28 29 issued initially for other than a 12-month period to facilitate an equal volume of 30 monthly issuances. The registration fee will be prorated for the period issued. 31 For the purpose of maintaining relatively uniform work loads, 32 monthly volumes of registration renewals shall be evaluated from time to time and 33 any portion of a monthly issuance may be rescheduled by applying a different 34 expiration date and prorating the fee accordingly. 35 The refund of registration fees on surrender of the registration card 36 and unused registration plates provided in § 13-938 of this article shall be made to 37 the owner only if the return is made prior to the expiration date of the registration

38 period for which application for refund is made.

- 1 (6) Whenever a prorated fee is assessed, the amount shall be calculated 2 by multiplying one-twelfth of the applicable fee by the number of months for which
- 3 the issuance or renewal is made and the resultant figure shall be adjusted to the
- 4 nearest dollar amount.
- 5 (e) The Administration may adopt rules and regulations to implement and
- 6 operate a staggered registration system.]
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 8 October 1, 1998.
