A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City - Board of Liquor License Commissioners - Alternate**
3 **Members**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor, with the advice and consent of the
5 Senate, to appoint a certain number of alternate members to the Board of Liquor
6 License Commissioners for Baltimore City; specifying the circumstances under
7 which an alternate member may serve on the Board; providing for the term,
8 powers, and duties of an alternate member; requiring that an alternate member
9 receive a certain salary for each day actually served; making this Act an
10 emergency measure; and generally relating to the Board of Liquor License
11 Commissioners for Baltimore City.

13 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

20 15-101.

21 (d) (1) The provisions of this section apply in Baltimore City.

22 (2) (I) THE GOVERNOR, WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE
23 SENATE, SHALL APPOINT EVERY 2 YEARS TWO ALTERNATE MEMBERS TO THE BOARD
24 OF LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSIONERS FOR BALTIMORE CITY.

25 (II) AN ALTERNATE MEMBER SHALL BE DESIGNATED BY THE
26 CHAIRMAN OF THE LIQUOR BOARD TO SERVE IF A REGULAR MEMBER IS ABSENT OR
27 INCAPACITATED FOR ANY REASON OR A VACANCY IS CREATED.

1 (III) AN ALTERNATE MEMBER SHALL SERVE UNTIL THE REGULAR
2 MEMBER'S INCAPACITY OR ABSENCE ENDS OR THE VACANCY IS FILLED.

3 (IV) WHILE ON THE BOARD, AN ALTERNATE MEMBER HAS ALL THE
4 POWERS AND DUTIES OF A REGULARLY APPOINTED MEMBER.

5 (V) AN ALTERNATE MEMBER SHALL RECEIVE A PER DIEM SALARY:

6 1. THAT THE BOARD SETS FOR EACH DAY ACTUALLY
7 SERVED; AND

8 2. THAT MAY NOT EXCEED THE DAILY SALARY OF A
9 REGULAR MEMBER.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
11 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety,
12 has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
13 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
14 the date it is enacted.
