## 2 Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Fines and Suspensions

- 3 FOR the purpose of clarifying that the Board of License Commissioners for Baltimore
- 4 City may impose both a fine and a suspension in cases in which certain
- 5 violations of the alcoholic beverages laws of Baltimore City occur; making this
- Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the alcoholic beverages

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 15 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- 16 16-507.
- 17 (d) For any violation that is cause for suspension under the alcoholic beverage
- 18 laws affecting Baltimore City, the Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners
- 19 may:
- 20 (1) For a first offense, impose a fine of not more than \$500 or suspend
- 21 the license OR BOTH; or
- 22 (2) For any subsequent offense, impose a fine of not more than \$1,000 or
- 23 suspend the license OR BOTH.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 25 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety,
- 26 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
- 27 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
- 28 the date it is enacted.
