- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 23 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO:
- 24 (1) INSURERS AND NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS THAT PROVIDE
- 25 HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS ON AN
- 26 EXPENSE-INCURRED BASIS UNDER HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES OR CONTRACTS
- 27 THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE; AND

- 1 (2) HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE HOSPITAL,

- 15 policies or contracts issued, delivered, or renewed in the State on or after October 1,
- 16 1998.
- 17 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 18 October 1, 1998.
