19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 3 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO:
- 4 (1) INSURERS AND NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS THAT PROVIDE
- 5 HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS ON AN
- 6 EXPENSE-INCURRED BASIS UNDER HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES OR CONTRACTS
- 7 THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE; AND
- 8 (2) HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE HOSPITAL,
- 9 MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS UNDER CONTRACTS
- 10 THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE.
- 11 (B) AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR
- 12 ONE A PROSTHESIS THAT HAS BEEN PRESCRIBED BY A PHYSICIAN FOR AN
- 13 ENROLLEE OR INSURED WHO HAS UNDERGONE A MASTECTOMY AND HAS NOT HAD
- 14 BREAST RECONSTRUCTION.
- 15 (C) A POLICY OR CONTRACT SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION MAY NOT IMPOSE A 16 DEDUCTIBLE ON THE COVERAGE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION.
