- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Family Law
- 16 12-101.
- 17 (E) A CHILD SUPPORT ORDER FOR A CHILD WHO IS ENROLLED IN SECONDARY
- 18 SCHOOL SHALL CONTINUE IN EFFECT UNTIL THE FIRST OF THE FOLLOWING EVENTS
- 19 OCCURS:
- 20 (1) THE CHILD GRADUATES FROM OR IS NO LONGER ENROLLED IN A
- 21 SECONDARY SCHOOL OR VOCATIONAL PROGRAM; OR
- 22 (2) THE CHILD ATTAINS THE AGE OF 20 YEARS.
- 23 (F) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT A COURT FROM MODIFYING A CHILD
- 24 SUPPORT ORDER UNDER § 12-104 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply only
- 26 to cases to establish or modify child support filed on or after the effective date of this
- 27 Act.

- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be considered to be a material change of circumstances for purposes of modifying a child support order issued before the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 5 October 1, 1998.
