- 1 (2) The population in the area or within a reasonable proximity within 2 that county to that area is a low-income poverty area on the basis of the most recent 3 census OR OTHER BASIS SATISFACTORY TO THE SECRETARY;
- 4 (3) At least 70 percent of the families living in the area or within a 5 reasonable proximity within that county to that area have incomes that are less than
- 6 an amount equal to 80 percent of the median family income within the political
- 7 subdivision in which the area is located; or
- 8 (4) Population in the area or within a reasonable proximity within that
- 9 county to that area decreased by 10 percent between the date of the most recent
- 10 census and the date of the immediately preceding census, and the political
- 11 subdivision can demonstrate to the Secretary's satisfaction that either chronic
- 12 abandonment or demolition of property is occurring in that area or substantial
- 13 property tax arrearages exist within that area.
- 14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 15 October 1, 1998.
