29 30	(A) Every motor vehicle that is used by nursery schools, camps, day nurseries, or day care centers for retarded children to transport children and that is not regulated as a "school bus" under this article, shall be equipped with seat belts for each seat and shall be subject to such other regulations as may be prescribed by the Administration.			

- 1 (B) (1) A SCHOOL BUS THAT IS PURCHASED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 1998, AND 2 USED TO TRANSPORT CHILDREN SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH SEAT BELTS OR OTHER 3 APPROPRIATE RESTRAINING DEVICES FOR EACH SEAT.
