- 2 Montgomery County F. Scott Fitzgerald Theatre and Rockville Civic 3 Center Complex Loan of 1997
- 4 FOR the purpose of amending Chapter 237 of the Acts of the General Assembly of
- 5 1997 to remove the historical easement provision; and making this Act an
- 6 emergency measure.
- 7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 8 Chapter 237 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1997
- 9 Section 1
- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 12 Chapter 237 of the Acts of 1997
- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That:
- 15 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 16 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Montgomery
- 17 County F. Scott Fitzgerald Theatre and Rockville Civic Center Complex Loan of
- 18 1997 in a total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$300,000 or (ii) the amount
- 19 of the matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall
- 20 be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds
- 21 authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and
- 22 delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and
- 23 Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 24 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 25 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 26 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 27 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 28 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 29 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then

- 1 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 2 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 3 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Mayor and City Council of Rockville
- 4 (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the repair, renovation, and
- 5 capital equipping of the F. Scott Fitzgerald Theatre and Rockville Civic Center,
- 6 located in Rockville Civic Center Park.
- 7 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 8 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and 9 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years 10 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 11 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 12 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 13 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 14 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 15 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind
- 16 contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any
- 17 dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify
- 18 as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the
- 19 Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 1999, to present evidence
- 20 satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If
- 21 satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of
- 22 the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the
- 23 amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act.
- 24 Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the
- 25 Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 26 [(6) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey
- 27 to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of
- 28 its interest:
- 29 (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
- 30 and
- 31 (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic
- 32 structures.
- 33 (b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust
- 34 and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.]
- 35 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 36 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety,
- 37 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
- 38 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
- 39 the date it is enacted.
