A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City - Board of License Commissioners - Personnel**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing certain provisions of law for Baltimore City concerning
4 the determination of salaries of personnel of the Board of License
5 Commissioners; establishing a schedule of salary grade levels for certain
6 employees of the Board; and generally relating to the Board of License
7 Commissioners for Baltimore City.

23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
24 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

25 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

26 15-112.

27 (d) (1) This subsection applies only in Baltimore City.

1 (9) (i) 1. In this paragraph, "inspectors" means full-time
 2 inspectors who are employees of the Board. "Inspectors" does not include an inspector
 3 supervisor or assistant inspector supervisor.

4 2. Inspectors who were appointed prior to October 1, 1997,
 5 shall continue their appointment after that date unless removed in accordance with
 6 classified civil service procedures.

7 (ii) As of October 1, 1997:

8 1. Inspectors are part of the classified civil service of the
 9 City;

10 2. The Board may appoint and remove inspectors only in
 11 accordance with the provisions of law that govern classified civil service employees of
 12 the City;

13 3. An employee of the Board may not solicit or receive,
 14 directly or indirectly or on behalf of another person, a commission, political
 15 contribution, remuneration, or gift from:

16 A. A licensee or other person who is engaged in the
 17 manufacture or sale of alcoholic beverages; or

18 B. An agent or employee of a licensee or other person who is
 19 engaged in the manufacture or sale of alcoholic beverages; and

20 4. An employee or other person specified in
 21 sub-subparagraph 3 of this subparagraph who violates the provisions of that
 22 sub-subparagraph is subject to the penalties specified in § 16-503 of this article.

23 (iii) The provisions of this paragraph do not alter the process by
 24 which inspectors' salaries are funded. [Salaries shall be determined by the City
 25 Department of Personnel under the compensation policies for classified employees of
 26 the Board. The Department shall ensure that salaries for the positions of Inspector I
 27 and Inspector II are comparable to similar positions elsewhere in the City
 28 government.]

29 (iv) The inspector supervisor and assistant inspector supervisor
 30 shall be residents of Baltimore City.

- 3 (VII) ADMINISTRATIVE COORDINATOR - GRADE 90;
- 4 (VIII) ASSISTANT CHIEF INSPECTOR - GRADE 090; AND
- 5 (IX) CHIEF INSPECTOR - GRADE 093.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 October 1, 1998.
