6 (B) AN EMPLOYER WHOSE ANNUAL GROSS INCOME IS \$250,000 OR LESS SHALL 7 PAY:

(1) TO EACH EMPLOYEE WHO IS SUBJECT TO BOTH THE FEDERAL ACT 9 AND THIS SUBTITLE, AT LEAST THE MINIMUM WAGE FOR THAT EMPLOYEE UNDER 10 THE FEDERAL ACT; AND
(2) EACH OTHER EMPLOYEE WHO IS SUBJECT TO THIS SUBTITLE, AT 12 LEAST:
(I) THE HIGHEST MINIMUM WAGE UNDER THE FEDERAL ACT; OR
