- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 14 (a) The Office of Public Defender is hereby established in the Executive
- 15 Branch of the government of the State of Maryland. The head of the Office shall be
- 16 the Public Defender, who shall be appointed by the board of trustees, and who shall
- 17 serve at the pleasure of the board of trustees. To be qualified for appointment as
- 18 Public Defender, a person must be an attorney-at-law, admitted to practice law in
- 19 the State of Maryland by the Court of Appeals of Maryland, and engaged in the
- 20 practice of law for a period of five (5) years prior to his appointment. The Public
- 21 Defender shall receive [such salary as provided in the budget, and shall] THE SAME
- 22 SALARY AS AN ASSOCIATE JUDGE OF A CIRCUIT COURT. THE PUBLIC DEFENDER MAY
- 23 not engage in the private practice of law.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 25 October 1, 1998.
