- All murder which shall be committed in the perpetration of, or attempt to
- 16 perpetrate, any rape in any degree, sexual offense in the first or second degree,
- 17 sodomy, mayhem, robbery, carjacking or armed carjacking, CHILD ABUSE AS DEFINED
- 18 IN § 35C OF THIS ARTICLE, burglary in the first, second, or third degree, a violation of
- 19 § 139C of this article concerning destructive devices, kidnapping as defined in §§ 337
- 20 and 338 of this article, or in the escape or attempt to escape from the Patuxent
