CHAPTER
1 AN ACT concerning
 Health Benefit Plans - Coverage for Prescription Contraceptive Drugs or Devices
FOR the purpose of requiring certain insurers, nonprofit health service plans, and health maintenance organizations to provide coverage under certain circumstances for contraceptive drugs or devices approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration for use as contraceptives; providing for an exception from the requirements of this Act; and imposing a certain limitation on administration of the coverage.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article - Insurance** 2 15-826. THIS SECTION APPLIES TO: 3 (A) INSURERS AND NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS THAT PROVIDE 5 COVERAGE FOR DRUGS UNDER HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES OR CONTRACTS THAT 6 ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE; AND HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE COVERAGE 8 FOR DRUGS UNDER CONTRACTS THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE: 9 AND. 10 HEALTH INSURANCE CONTRACTS OR POLICIES THAT PROVIDE 11 COVERAGE FOR DRUGS AND THAT ARE ISSUED TO SMALL EMPLOYERS UNDER 12 SUBTITLE 12 OF THIS TITLE. 13 (B) AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION: SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR ANY CONTRACEPTIVE DRUG OR 14 15 DEVICE THAT IS APPROVED BY THE UNITED STATES FOOD AND DRUG 16 ADMINISTRATION FOR USE AS A CONTRACEPTIVE AND THAT IS OBTAINED UNDER A 17 PRESCRIPTION WRITTEN BY AN AUTHORIZED PRESCRIBER AS DEFINED IN § 12-101 18 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE: SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR THE INSERTION AND ANY 20 MEDICALLY NECESSARY EXAMINATION ASSOCIATED WITH THE USE OF SUCH 21 CONTRACEPTIVE DRUG OR DEVICE; AND 22 MAY NOT IMPOSE A DIFFERENT COPAYMENT OR COINSURANCE FOR 23 A CONTRACEPTIVE DRUG OR DEVICE THAN IS IMPOSED FOR ANY OTHER 24 PRESCRIPTION. A RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION MAY REQUEST AND AN INSURER, 26 NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN, OR HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION 27 SHALL GRANT THE REQUEST FOR AN EXCEPTION FROM THE COVERAGE REQUIRED 28 UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IF THE REQUIRED COVERAGE CONFLICTS 29 WITH THE RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION'S BONA FIDE RELIGIOUS BELIEFS AND 30 PRACTICES. 31 A RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION THAT OBTAINS AN EXCEPTION FROM 32 THE REQUIRED COVERAGE SHALL PROVIDE ITS EMPLOYEES REASONABLE AND 33 TIMELY NOTICE OF THIS EXCEPTION. 34 THE PREMIUM RATE FOR THE POLICY OR CONTRACT OF THE 35 INSURER, NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN, OR HEALTH MAINTENANCE 36 ORGANIZATION MAY NOT BE AFFECTED BY THE RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION'S

37 EXCEPTION FROM THE REQUIRED COVERAGE.
