- 21 WHEREAS, Each health occupation board has a mandate to protect the health,
- 22 safety, and welfare of the citizens of the State by licensing, regulating, and
- 23 disciplining health care practitioners;
- 24 WHEREAS, The health occupations boards have made significant progress in
- 25 addressing this mandate since the General Assembly established the boards as
- 26 special funded agencies in 1993;
- 27 WHEREAS, The health occupations boards assign the highest priority to
- 28 addressing disciplinary matters related to complaints received against licensees;

- **SENATE BILL 352** 1 WHEREAS, Each health occupation board has difficulty in predicting the 2 amount of funds necessary to meet certain costs related to disciplinary actions, 3 litigation, and certain legislative mandates; 4 WHEREAS, Current policy requires a health occupations board to submit a 5 proposed budget amendment in order to access its surplus funds each time the board 6 incurs an unanticipated expense related to a disciplinary action, litigation, and certain legislative mandates; 8 WHEREAS, If the performance of each health occupation board is to 9 significantly improve, a reform allowing each board to establish a project reserve 10 fund, to be expended on unanticipated expenses related to disciplinary actions, litigation, and certain legislative mandates, must be implemented; and 12 WHEREAS, No health occupation board will increase fees for its services in 13 order to establish a project reserve fund or to allocate money to the project reserve 14 fund; now, therefore, 15 SECTION 1. 


