3 FOR the purpose of altering certain requirements for overtime compensation for
4 certain employees on certain public work projects; and providing for a delayed

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - State Finance and Procurement**

15 17-214.

16 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, each contractor and
17 subcontractor under a public work contract shall pay not less than the prevailing
18 wage rate of straight time to an employee for each hour that the employee works.

19 (b) A contractor and subcontractor shall pay an employee the prevailing wage
20 rate of overtime for each hour that the employee works:

- 21 (1) in excess of [10] 8 hours in any single calendar day;
- 22 (2) in excess of 40 hours per each workweek; or
- 23 (3) on Sunday or a legal holiday.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
25 effect January 1, 1999.
