16 (b) In the following jurisdictions the specified exceptions to subsection (a) of 17 this section apply:
18 (2) In Baltimore City a licensee:
19 (I) [may] MAY employ a person 18 years of age or older to sell, 20 serve, deliver, or otherwise deal with alcoholic beverages;

- 1 (II) MAY NOT EMPLOY OR ALLOW A PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF 18
- $2\;$ YEARS TO SELL, SERVE, OR DELIVER, OR OTHERWISE DEAL WITH ALCOHOLIC
- 3 BEVERAGES; AND
- 4 (III) MAY NOT EMPLOY OR ALLOW A PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF 18
- 5 YEARS TO PROVIDE ENTERTAINMENT ON THE LICENSED PREMISES.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 7 October 1, 1998.
