- 18 (A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, WHEN REVIEW BY A
- 19 COURT IN BANC IS AUTHORIZED BY THE MARYLAND CONSTITUTION, AN INDIVIDUAL
- 20 MAY HAVE A JUDGMENT OR DETERMINATION OF ANY POINT OR QUESTION
- 21 RELATING TO A CONVICTION OR SENTENCE REVIEWED BY A THREE-JUDGE PANEL
- 22 SITTING IN BANC BY FILING A NOTICE FOR IN BANC REVIEW ANY TIME AFTER THE
- 23 INDIVIDUAL HAS SERVED AT LEAST 20 CONTINUOUS YEARS OF IMPRISONMENT
- 24 WITHOUT BEING RELEASED ON PAROLE AS A RESULT OF THE CONVICTION AND
- 25 SENTENCE.
- 26 (B) THE COURT OF APPEALS SHALL ADOPT RULES TO IMPLEMENT THIS

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 1998.
