1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Garrett County - Industrial Engineer - Repeal**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing from the Public Local Laws of Garrett County
4 provisions pertaining to the position of Industrial Engineer; and making certain
5 stylistic changes.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
7 The Public Local Laws of Garrett County
8 Section 20-6
9 Article 12 - Public Local Laws of Maryland
10 (1985 Edition and December 1997 Supplement, as amended)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article 12 - Garrett County**

14 20-6.

15 [A. Industrial Engineer. The County Commissioners of Garrett County are
16 hereby authorized to employ an Industrial Engineer, whose annual salary and
17 expenses shall not exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.). The Industrial
18 Engineer shall be a person with wide and varied experience in the field of industry
19 and allied economic endeavors. It shall be the duty of the Industrial Engineer to
20 publicize the merits of Garrett County for all types of industry and to aid industry in
21 locating in Garrett County. It shall also be the duty of the Industrial Engineer to
22 assist those industries presently located in Garrett County and to administer an
23 overall program of economic development for Garrett County. The County

1 Commissioners, in their discretion, may engage the services of a company or agency
2 to locate sites for industrial expansion and for industries seeking locations.

3 B. Committee on Economic Development.] The County Commissioners shall
4 [also] appoint a Committee on Economic Development, to be composed of [five (5)] 5
5 members, who shall represent the geographical areas of Garrett County. The
6 members of the Committee shall serve without compensation and at the pleasure of
7 the County Commissioners. It shall be the duty of the Committee on Economic
8 Development [to assist the Industrial Engineer in an advisory capacity and] to assist
9 in the development of an overall program of economic development for Garrett
10 County.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
12 effect July 1, 1998.
