CHAPTER
1 AN ACT concerning
St. Mary's County - Crab Harvesting - Prohibition on Use of Bank Traps and Channel Pounds
 FOR the purpose of prohibiting <u>after a certain date</u> the use of bank traps or channel pounds by persons harvesting crabs in St. Mary's County; <u>and directing the</u> <u>Department of Natural Resources to conduct a certain study and provide a</u> certain report with recommendations to the General Assembly by a certain date.
8 BY adding to 9 Article - Natural Resources 10 Section 4-815 11 Annotated Code of Maryland 12 (1997 Replacement Volume and 1997 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

- 2 4-815.
- 3 IN ST. MARY'S COUNTY, A PERSON MAY NOT HARVEST CRABS WITH A BANK TRAP 4 OR A CHANNEL POUND <u>AFTER OCTOBER 1, 2000</u>.
- 5 <u>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That the Department of
- 6 Natural Resources shall conduct a study of the impacts of bank traps and channel
- 7 pounds on aquatic animals, including crabs, fish, turtles, birds, and mammals. The
- 8 Department shall include in its study whether mitigating measures are available to
- 9 prevent adverse impacts upon aquatic animals. The study shall also consider the
- 10 effectiveness and enforcement of current bank trap regulations. The study shall
- 11 <u>continue over a 1-year period</u>, and upon completion of this report, and no later than
- 12 December 1, 1999, the Department shall report its findings to the House
- 13 Environmental Matters Committee and the Senate Economic Affairs Committee. In its
- 14 report, the Department shall make recommendations as to whether the prohibition on
- 15 the use of bank traps and channel pounds in St. Mary's County should be repealed by
- 16 the General Assembly.
- 17 SECTION 2. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 18 effect October 1, 1998.
