## Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

3 (a) (1) On approval by the board of license commissioners for that 4 jurisdiction, if any, of a proper application, made on forms prescribed by the State 5 Comptroller, signed and sworn to, the license issuing authority may grant the types of 6 special licenses for the periods and at the fees specified in this section.

(i) A special beer, wine and liquor license, Class C licensee may
