CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Alcoholic Beverages - Anne Arundel County - Special Licenses**

3 FOR the purpose of exempting ~~1 day~~ certain special alcoholic beverages licenses in
4 Anne Arundel County from certain application, notice, and hearing
5 requirements; and generally relating to special alcoholic beverages licenses in
6 the ~~State~~ County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

9 Section 7-101(a), (b)(1) and (2), and (d)(1) and (2)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

2 7-101.

3 (a) (1) On approval by the board of license commissioners for that
4 jurisdiction, if any, of a proper application, made on forms prescribed by the State
5 Comptroller, signed and sworn to, the license issuing authority may grant the types of
6 special licenses for the periods and at the fees specified in this section.

7 (2) For an application for a statewide license, the Comptroller may grant
8 the license.

9 (3) IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, THE PROVISIONS OF §§ 10-103(B) AND
10 10-202 OF THIS ARTICLE AND § 10-501 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE DO NOT
11 APPLY TO AN APPLICANT FOR A SPECIAL CLASS C BEER LICENSE, SPECIAL CLASS C
12 BEER AND WINE LICENSE, OR SPECIAL CLASS C BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE
13 THAT IS NOT TO EXCEED 1 DAY FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 7 CONSECUTIVE DAYS
14 FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE LICENSE.

15 (b) (1) (i) Subject to subsection (a) of this section, a special Class C beer
16 license or a special Class C beer and wine license entitles the holder to exercise any of
17 the privileges conferred by the respective classes of licenses for the use of any person
18 holding any bona fide entertainment conducted by any club, society or association at
19 the place described in the license, for a period not exceeding seven consecutive days
20 from the effective date thereof.

21 (ii) The fee is \$5 per day.

22 (2) In Anne Arundel County:

23 (I) [the] THE fee is \$10 per day; AND

24 (II) THE PROVISIONS OF §§ 10-103(B) AND 10-202 OF THIS ARTICLE
25 AND § 10-501 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE DO NOT APPLY TO AN APPLICANT
26 FOR EITHER THE SPECIAL CLASS C BEER LICENSE OR THE SPECIAL CLASS C BEER
27 AND WINE LICENSE.

28 (d) (1) (i) A special Class C beer, wine and liquor license entitles the
29 holder to exercise any of the privileges conferred by this class of license for the use of
30 any person holding a bona fide entertainment conducted by a club, society, or
31 association at the place described for a period not exceeding seven consecutive days,
32 upon the payment of a fee of \$15 per day.

33 (ii) The provisions of § 11-517 of this article do not apply to holders
34 of this license. Alcoholic beverages sold under this special license shall be purchased
35 by such special license holder from retail dealers.

36 (2) In Anne Arundel County:

1 (i) A special beer, wine and liquor license, Class C licensee may
2 purchase beer from a wholesaler[.];

3 (ii) The fee is \$25 per day[.]; AND

4 (III) THE PROVISIONS OF §§ 10-103(B) AND 10-202 OF THIS ARTICLE
5 AND § 10-501 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE DO NOT APPLY TO AN APPLICANT
6 FOR THE LICENSE.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 1998.
