3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the counties from using State funding intended for 4 the minimal library program for any other obligation of local funding for 5 libraries requiring a certain appropriation by local governments in order to 6 receive certain funding increases in the minimum library program; and 7 generally relating to funding of the minimum library program.
8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 9 Article - Education 10 Section 23-507 11 Annotated Code of Maryland 12 (1997 Replacement Volume and 1997 Supplement)
13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (A) A COUNTY MAY NOT USE STATE FUNDING INTENDED FOR THE MINIMUM 18 LIBRARY PROGRAM TO MEET ANY OTHER OBLIGATION FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF 19 LOCAL FUNDING FOR LIBRARIES IN ORDER TO RECEIVE AN INCREASE IN THE STATE 20 SHARE OF THE MINIMUM LIBRARY PROGRAM, A COUNTY GOVERNING BODY SHALL 21 APPROPRIATE LOCAL FUNDS FOR THE MINIMUM LIBRARY PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT 22 NO LESS THAN THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED IN THE PRIOR EISCAL YEAR

- 1 (B) The State Superintendent shall authorize the State Comptroller to 2 withhold State funds from any county that fails:
- 3 (1) To appropriate the amount of its share of the minimum program; or
- 4 (2) To meet the requirements of the law or of the State Board for 5 operating the county library.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1 July 1, 1998.
