- 30 (II) IS AN INDIVIDUAL FOR WHOM LACK OF TREATMENT CAN BE
- 31 EXPECTED TO RESULT IN ORAL PAIN, INFECTION, LOSS OF TEETH, OR OTHER
- 32 INCREASED ORAL OR DENTAL MORBIDITY.
- 33 (C) AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION MAY REQUIRE PRIOR
- 34 AUTHORIZATION FOR GENERAL ANESTHESIA AND ASSOCIATED HOSPITAL OR

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- (D) 1 AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION MAY RESTRICT COVERAGE FOR 2 GENERAL ANESTHESIA AND ASSOCIATED HOSPITAL OR AMBULATORY FACILITY 3 CHARGES TO DENTAL CARE THAT IS PROVIDED BY A: 4 DENTIST TO WHOM HOSPITAL PRIVILEGES HAVE BEEN GRANTED; **(1)** 5 AND 6 (2) FULLY ACCREDITED SPECIALIST IN: 7 (I) PEDIATRIC DENTISTRY -; OR ORAL AND MAXILLOFACIAL SURGERY, OR OTHER RECOGNIZED 8 (II)9 DENTAL SPECIALITY FOR WHICH HOSPITAL PRIVILEGES MAY BE GRANTED. 10 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO REQUIRE 11 COVERAGE FOR THE DENTAL CARE FOR WHICH THE GENERAL ANESTHESIA IS 12 PROVIDED. 13 (F) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION DO NOT APPLY TO DENTAL CARE 14 RENDERED FOR TEMPORAL MANDIBULAR JOINT DISORDERS. 15 **Article - Health - General** 16 19-706. 17 The provisions of §§ 15-105, 15-112, 15-113, 15-804, [and] 15-812, AND 18 15-826 of the Insurance Article shall apply to health maintenance organizations. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all 19 20 new plans, policies, or contracts issued or delivered in the State on or after January 1, 21 1999, and to the renewal of all plans, policies, or contracts in effect before January 1, 22 1999, except that any plan, policy, or contract in effect before January 1, 1999 shall 23 comply with the provisions of this Act no later than July 1, 1999.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 July 1, 1998.
