CHAPTER____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt - Montgomery County Agricultural Center

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$495,000
- \$400,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the
- 5 Montgomery County Agricultural Center, Inc. for certain development or
- 6 improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject
- 7 to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and
- 8 providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 10 MARYLAND, That:

- 11 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 12 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Montgomery
- 13 County Agricultural Center Loan of 1998 in a total principal amount equal to the
- 14 lesser of (i) \$495,000 \$400,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in
- 15 accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale,
- 16 and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board
- 17 of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through
- 18 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 19 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as 20 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 21 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 22 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 23 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 24 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then

- 1 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 2 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 3 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Montgomery
- 4 County Agricultural Center, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for
- 5 the repair, renovation, and capital equipping for an existing building, infrastructure
- 6 upgrades, including those that are necessary for ADA compliance, and for the
- 7 planning, design, and construction of the Montgomery County, Agribusiness, and
- 8 Agricultural Education Center on the grounds of the Agricultural Center in
- 9 Gaithersburg.
- 10 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 11 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 12 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 13 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 14 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 15 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee, the County Executive and
- 16 County Council, and the Mayor and City Council of the City of Gaithersburg shall
- 17 jointly provide and expend a matching fund. Of the total matching fund, the County
- 18 Executive and County Council of Montgomery County pledge \$247,500 and the
- 19 grantee pledges \$247,500. The grantee, however, is responsible for the provision of the
- 20 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 21 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 22 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind
- 23 contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any
- 24 dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify
- 25 as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the
- 26 Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2000, to present evidence
- 27 satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If
- 28 satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of
- 29 the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the
- 30 amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act.
- 31 Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the
- 32 Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 33 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 34 June 1, 1998.
