3 (B) THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FREDERICK COUNTY MAY 4 ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR:

5 (1) REGISTERING ALARM SYSTEM CONTRACTORS OPERATING IN THE 6 COUNTY;

7 (2) REGISTERING ALARM USERS IN THE COUNTY;

8 (3) PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR FAILURE TO REGISTER AS AN ALARM 9 SYSTEM CONTRACTOR OR ALARM USER;

10(4)PROVIDING CIVIL CITATIONS AND PENALTIES FOR FALSE ALARMS,11NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS IN ARTICLE 27, § 156C OF THE CODE; AND

16 (a) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY IN FREDERICK COUNTY IF THE BOARD OF
17 COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FREDERICK COUNTY ADOPTS REGULATIONS UNDER
18 ARTICLE 25, § 221A OF THE CODE PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTRATION OF ALARM
19 SYSTEM CONTRACTORS AND ALARM USERS AND THE ISSUANCE OF CIVIL CITATIONS
20 AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE REGULATIONS.

21 (B) Except for alarm systems activated by acts of God, weather conditions, or

22 causes beyond the control of the alarm user, an alarm system that is negligently or

23 accidentally activated as the result of faulty, malfunctioning, or improperly installed

24 or maintained equipment shall be subject to the provisions of subsections (b) and (c) of

25 this section.

26 [(b)] (C) A law enforcement agency or fire department may issue a civil 27 citation to an alarm user if the number of false alarms to which any law enforcement 28 agency or fire department actually responds exceeds:

- 29 (1) 3 responses within a 30-day period; or
- 30 (2) 8 or more responses within a 12-month period.
- 31 [(c)] (D) The civil citation shall include a fine of:
- 32 (1) \$30 for each initial false alarm; and
- 33 (2) \$30 for each additional false alarm.
