- 11 WHEREAS, Teeth from the dinosaur Astrodon johnstoni were first recovered
- 12 in Muirkirk, Maryland in 1858; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The Astrodon johnstoni was the first identified dinosaur in
- 14 Maryland and was one of the earliest dinosaur finds in the United States; and
- WHEREAS, The Astrodon johnstoni was the first sauropod described in North
- 16 America; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The largest dinosaur bone ever found in the State was the leg
- 18 bone of an Astrodon johnstoni, discovered in 1991 in a quarry in Muirkirk, Maryland;
- 19 now, therefore,
- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 22 Article State Government

- 24 THE ASTRODON JOHNSTONI IS THE STATE DINOSAUR.
