1 AN ACT concerning
2 State Dinosaur - Astrodon Johnstoni
3 FOR the purpose of designating the dinosaur "Astrodon johnstoni" as the State4 dinosaur.
5 BY adding to 6 Article - State Government 7 Section 13-315 8 Annotated Code of Maryland 9 (1995 Replacement Volume and 1997 Supplement)
10 Preamble
WHEREAS, Teeth from the dinosaur Astrodon johnstoni were first recovered in Muirkirk, Maryland in 1858; and
WHEREAS, The Astrodon johnstoni was the first identified dinosaur in Maryland and was one of the earliest dinosaur finds in the United States; and
WHEREAS, The Astrodon johnstoni was the first sauropod described in North America; and
WHEREAS, The largest dinosaur bone ever found in the State was the leg bone of an Astrodon johnstoni, discovered in 1991 in a quarry in Muirkirk, Maryland; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article - State Government**

- THE ASTRODON JOHNSTONI IS THE STATE DINOSAUR.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 5 effect October 1, 1998.
