- 2 Creation of a State Debt Prince George's County Showplace Arena (Equestrian Center)
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$1,500,000,
- 5 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the County Executive and County Council
- of Prince George's County for certain acquisition, development, or improvement
- 7 purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a
- 8 requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and
- 9 providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

11 MARYLAND, That:

- 12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Prince
- 14 George's County Showplace Arena (Equestrian Center) Loan of 1998 in a total
- 15 principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$1,500,000 or (ii) the amount of the
- 16 matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be
- 17 evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds
- 18 authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and
- 19 delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and
- 20 Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 21 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 22 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 23 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 24 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 25 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 26 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 27 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 28 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 29 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the County Executive and County Council
- 30 of Prince George's County (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the
- 31 planning, design, renovation, repair, and capital equipping of the Showplace Arena
- 32 (also known as the Equestrian Center) in Upper Marlboro, the renovation to include

- 1 retrofitting of the facility to include an ice rink to be used by an East Coast Hockey
- 2 League (ECHL) professional hockey team that is affiliated with a National Hockey
- 3 League team and also to include locker rooms, shower facilities, box seats, and other
- 4 installations, capital equipment, and capital furnishings that are necessary for
- 5 professional hockey games to be played at the facility, as well as other capital
- 6 expenses involved.
- 7 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 8 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 9 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 10 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 11 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 12 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 13 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 14 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 15 unappropriated. The fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds
- 16 expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount
- 17 of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the
- 18 Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final.
- 19 The grantee has until June 1, 2000, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of
- 20 Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is
- 21 presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to
- 22 the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching
- 23 fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan
- 24 in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works
- 25 shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 27 June 1, 1998.
