1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Carroll County - Board of Education - Compensation**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the annual compensation of the chairman and the
4 other members of the Carroll County Board of Education; providing for the
5 method of payment for the compensation; providing that this Act does not apply
6 to the compensation of the incumbent members of the Board; and generally
7 relating to the compensation of the chairman and the other members of the
8 Carroll County Board of Education.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Education**

17 3-403.

18 (A) The chairman of the County Board is entitled to receive [~~\$2,000~~] \$3,500
19 annually as compensation and the other members are entitled to receive [~~\$1,800~~]
20 \$3,000 each annually as compensation.

1 (B) THE COMPENSATION OF THE CHAIRMAN AND THE MEMBERS DESCRIBED
2 IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE PAID IN FOUR EQUAL QUARTERLY
3 INSTALLMENTS.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
5 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
6 apply to the compensation of the chairman and members of the Carroll County Board
7 of Education in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act
8 concerning the compensation of the chairman and members of the Carroll County
9 Board of Education shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of
10 office.

11 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 July 1, 1998.
