BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions** 15 21-104. 16 (d) (1) (i) The term of an appointed or elected trustee is [4] 6 years. 17 (ii) Trustees who represent the public serve staggered [4-year] 18 6-YEAR terms. 19 A trustee who is a member but not a retiree of the Correctional 20 Officers' Retirement System, the Employees' Pension System, the Employees' 21 Retirement System, the Judges' Retirement System, the Legislative Pension Plan, the 22 Local Fire and Police System, the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension Plan, the State 23 Police Retirement System, the Teachers' Pension System, or the Teachers' Retirement 24 System at the time of election of the trustee may complete the term of office even if, 25 during the term, the trustee becomes a retiree of the State system of which the 26 trustee was a member at the time of election. A vacancy in the office of a trustee shall be filled for the unexpired

- 1 (4) At the end of a term, a trustee continues to serve until a successor is 2 appointed or elected.
- A trustee who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the 4 rest of the term and until a successor is selected and qualifies.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 1998 and shall be applicable to the term of an appointed or elected trustee
