12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

8 (4) At the end of a term, a trustee continues to serve until a successor is 9 appointed or elected.

10 (5) A trustee who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the 11 rest of the term and until a successor is selected and qualifies.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

13 October 1, 1998 and shall be applicable to the term of an appointed or elected trustee

14 of the Board of Trustees for the State Retirement System that begins on or after

15 October 1, 1998.
