- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 17 (a) The Commission retains jurisdiction pending an appeal to consider a
- 18 request for additional medical treatment and attention, ADDITIONAL TEMPORARY
- 19 TOTAL DISABILITY BENEFITS, AND VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION SERVICES.
- 20 (b) If the Commission finds that a covered employee needs additional medical
- 21 attention, ADDITIONAL TEMPORARY TOTAL DISABILITY BENEFITS, OR VOCATIONAL
- 22 REHABILITATION SERVICES pending an appeal, the Commission may pass a
- 23 supplemental order requiring the employer to provide additional medical treatment
- 24 and attention, ADDITIONAL TEMPORARY TOTAL DISABILITY BENEFITS, AND
- 25 VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION SERVICES.
- 26 (c) A supplemental order passed by the Commission under this section is
- 27 subject to review on the pending appeal.

- 1 (d) When an appeal that is pending relates solely to a penalty imposed by the 2 Commission, the Commission retains jurisdiction over all matters in the case other
- 3 than imposition of the penalty.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
