A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Health Insurance - Cleft Lip and Cleft Palate - Coverage**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring health maintenance organizations to provide coverage
4 for the treatment of cleft lip or cleft palate or both; and generally relating to the
5 provision of coverage for the treatment of cleft lip or cleft palate or both.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article - Health - General**

19 19-706.

20 (Y) THE PROVISIONS OF § 15-818 OF THE INSURANCE ARTICLE SHALL APPLY
21 TO HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS.

22 **Article - Insurance**

23 15-818.

24 (a) This section applies to:

1 (1) each individual or group hospital or major medical insurance policy
2 or certificate that is delivered or issued for delivery in the State by an insurer and is
3 written on an expense-incurred basis; [and]

4 (2) each individual or group medical or major medical contract, policy, or
5 certificate that is delivered or issued for delivery in the State by a nonprofit health
6 service plan; AND

7 (3) HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE HOSPITAL,
8 MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS UNDER CONTRACTS
9 THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE.

10 (b) A policy, contract, or certificate subject to this section shall include benefits
11 for inpatient or outpatient expenses arising from orthodontics, oral surgery, and
12 otologic, audiological, and speech/language treatment involved in the management of
13 the birth [defects] DEFECT known as cleft lip [and] OR cleft palate OR BOTH.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 October 1, 1998.
