- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (i) Except as limited by federal requirements, temporary cash assistance shall
- 21 be determined with due regard to the available resources and necessary expenditures
- 22 of the family and the conditions existing in each case and shall be sufficient, when
- 23 added to all other income and support available to the child, to provide the child with
- 24 a reasonable subsistence compatible with decency and health.
- 25 (J) IN DETERMINING INCOME ELIGIBILITY FOR TEMPORARY CASH
- 26 ASSISTANCE, THE INCOME OF A STEPPARENT MAY NOT BE CONSIDERED.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 1998.
