- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 12 Article State Government
- 13 7-206.2.
- 14 (a) The Division may arrange for data bases derived from publications issued
- 15 by the Division to be made available to the public for direct on-line searching by
- 16 contracting with third-party or value-added resellers.
- 17 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a) of this section, the State
- 18 Data Center shall charge for on-line access to the Maryland Information Retrieval
- 19 System.
- 20 (c) This section may not be construed to require a State data center to provide
- 21 a member of the public with direct on-line access or any other type of access to the
- 22 computers or data bases of the State Data Center.
- 23 (D) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE DIVISION SHALL
- 24 MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC, AT NO COST, DIRECT ON-LINE SEARCHING OF:
- 25 (1) THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS;
- 26 (2) THE MARYLAND REGISTER; AND

- 1 (3) ANY OTHER MATERIAL THE DIVISION DETERMINES TO BE IN THE
- 2 PUBLIC INTEREST.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 4 October 1, 1998.
