A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Horse Racing - Off-Track Facilities - County Approval 3 FOR the purpose of requiring that a satellite simulcast facility for pari-mutuel betting on horse races be approved by the governing body of the county in which 4 it is located before beginning operations; providing for the application of this 5 6 Act; and generally relating to satellite simulcast facilities. 7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article - Business Regulation 8 9 Section 11-825(a) 10 Annotated Code of Maryland (1992 Volume and 1997 Supplement) 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 **Article - Business Regulation** 15 11-825. A satellite simulcast facility: 16 (a) 17 (1)shall be in premises owned or leased by a permit holder; TO BEGIN OPERATIONS, SHALL RECEIVE BY LOCAL LAW THE 18 (2)19 APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH IT IS LOCATED; (3) may not be within a 35-mile radius of any mile thoroughbred track or 20 21 harness track unless approved by the track licensee, the group that represents a 22 majority of the applicable owners and trainers licensed in the State and the group 23 that represents a majority of the applicable breeders in the State, considered 24 separately;

- 25 [(3)] (4) unless the track agrees otherwise, may not operate during
- 26 hours on those days that racing with pari-mutuel betting is permitted at a racetrack 27 located in this State within a 35-mile radius of the satellite simulcast facility; and
- 27 located in this State within a 35-mile radius of the satellite simulcast facility; and

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1[(4)](5)shall offer pari-mutuel betting facilities and amenities that the2Commission finds are:

3 (i) comparable to those available in the sports palace facilities of 4 the mile thoroughbred racing licensees including:

5 1. high quality dining, lounge, and seating areas that are of a 6 manner generally found in fine restaurants; and

2. teletheatre screen capacity; and

8 (ii) appropriate for the area where the satellite simulcast facility is 9 located.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be

11 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect12 on or application to any satellite simulcast facility in operation before the effective13 date of this Act.

14 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 15 effect October 1, 1998.

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
