BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 **Article - State Finance and Procurement** 16 14-406. IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 17 (A) (1) 18 INDICATED. 19 "PREFERENCE" MEANS AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO 5% OF THE LOWEST (2)20 RESPONSIVE BID RECEIVED IN RESPONSE TO AN INVITATION FOR BIDS FOR A 21 PROCUREMENT CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION. "PREFERRED BIDDER" MEANS A PERSON: 22 (3)WHO SUBMITS A RESPONSIVE BID IN RESPONSE TO AN 23 (I) 24 INVITATION FOR BIDS FOR A PROCUREMENT CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION; OR

WHOSE PAYROLL CONSISTS OF EMPLOYEES AT LEAST 65% OF

- 1 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY WHEN A PREFERENCE WOULD CONFLICT
- 2 WITH FEDERAL LAW OR PROVISIONS OF A FEDERAL GRANT AFFECTING THE
- 3 PROCUREMENT CONTRACT.
- 4 (C) WHEN A UNIT USES COMPETITIVE SEALED BIDDING TO AWARD A
- 5 PROCUREMENT CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION, THE UNIT SHALL GRANT THE
- 6 CONTRACT TO A PREFERRED BIDDER IF:
- 7 (1) THE PREFERRED BIDDER SUBMITS THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID 8 AMONG PREFERRED BIDDERS; AND
- 9 (2) THE BID, AFTER SUBTRACTING THE PREFERENCE UNDER THIS 10 SECTION, DOES NOT EXCEED THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID.
- 11 (D) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 October 1, 1998.
