14 15	Each producer, refiner, or wholesaler of motor fuel who supplies motor fuel to retail service station dealers:
16 17	(1) shall extend all voluntary allowances uniformly to all retail service station dealers supplied;
18 19	(2) shall apply all equipment rentals uniformly to all retail service station dealers supplied; and
20	(3) during periods of shortage:
21 22	(i) shall apportion uniformly and equitably all gasoline and special fuel to all retail service station dealers supplied; and
23 24	(ii) may not discriminate among retail service station dealers supplied in their allotments.
