- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 3 In the estates of decedents law, the word court means the orphans' court in a
- 4 county, or the court exercising the jurisdiction of the orphans' court in a county.

- 6 (h) Each of the judges of the Court for Carroll County shall receive an annual 7 compensation of [\$7,500] \$10,000 to be paid monthly. Each judge shall also be allowed 8 \$200 annually for traveling expenses, payable quarterly.
