	(a) Each regular member of a local board shall receive the salary and reimbursement of expenses provided in the county budget, but in no event may the annual compensation be less than the following amounts:  (7) In Carroll County, [\$800] \$3,000;

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the members of the Board of Supervisors of Elections for Carroll County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the members of the Board shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.
28 29 30 31 32 33	this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.  SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect January 1, 1999, contingent on the taking effect of Chapter (S.B. 118/H.B. 127) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1998. If Chapter becomes effective, Section 1 of this Act shall become null and void. If Chapter does not become effective, Section 1 of this Act shall remain in effect and Section 2 of this Act shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly.
