CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Election Code - Carroll County Election Board - Salaries**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salaries of the members of the Board of Supervisors
4 of Elections for Carroll County; providing for certain effective dates, subject to a
5 certain contingency; and providing that this Act does not affect the compensation
6 of the incumbent members of the Board.

5 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 6 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

7 **Article 33 - Election Code**

9 (a) Each member of the boards of the several political subdivisions of the State
 10 shall receive an annual salary of not less than the following amounts:

11 (7) Carroll County: [\$800] ~~THE AMOUNT SET BY THE COUNTY~~
 12 ~~COMMISSIONERS, NOT TO EXCEED \$2,000~~ \$3,000.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland
 14 read as follows:

17 (a) Each regular member of a local board shall receive the salary and
 18 reimbursement of expenses provided in the county budget, but in no event may the
 19 annual compensation be less than the following amounts:

20 (7) In Carroll County, [\$800] \$3,000;

21 SECTION ~~2.~~ 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article
 22 III, Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to
 23 extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the members of the Board of
 24 Supervisors of Elections for Carroll County in office on the effective date of this Act,
 25 but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the members of
 26 the Board shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

27 SECTION ~~3.~~ 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 1 and 3 of
 28 this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

29 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act
 30 shall take effect January 1, 1999, contingent on the taking effect of Chapter _____ (S.B.
 31 118/H.B. 127) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1998. If Chapter _____ becomes
 32 effective, Section 1 of this Act shall become null and void. If Chapter _____ does not
 33 become effective, Section 1 of this Act shall remain in effect and Section 2 of this Act
 34 shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly.
