3 FOR the purpose of requiring a study to be conducted on the procedures for placement

4 of at-risk youth and adult populations in State and residential facilities, and

5 other residential locations and recommendations be developed regarding a

#### 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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#### Article - Family Law

16 5-507.1.

#### 17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "AT-RISK YOUTH OR ADULT" MEANS:

18 (1) CHILDREN WHO ARE IN DANGER OF REPEATEDLY COMMITTING19 CRIMES AND ENGAGING IN ANTISOCIAL BEHAVIOR;

20 (2) CHILDREN WHO DO NOT RECEIVE NEEDED CARE FROM FAMILY OR 21 LEGAL GUARDIANS;

22 (3) CHILDREN WHO SUFFER FROM PHYSICAL OR MENTAL DISABILITIES; 23 AND

24 (4) AT-RISK ADULTS MEANS ADULTS WHO MAY BE ON PAROLE OR 25 PROBATION AND WHO MAY BE IN NEED OF STATE SERVICES.

#### **SENATE BILL 629**

(B) THE DEPARTMENTS OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE, HUMAN
RESOURCES, EDUCATION, AND JUVENILE JUSTICE SHALL JOINTLY CONDUCT A
STUDY ON THE PLACEMENT OF AT-RISK YOUTH AND ADULTS IN STATE FACILITIES,
OR IN RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES.

5 (C) THE STUDY SHALL MAKE FINDINGS AS TO:

6 (1) HOW THE STATE DETERMINES WHETHER PLACEMENT IS 7 NECESSARY;

8 (2) HOW THE DEPARTMENTS CONDUCTING THE STUDY DETERMINE THE 9 LOCATION FOR PLACEMENT OF AT-RISK YOUTH OR ADULTS;

10 (3) HOW AT-RISK YOUTH OR ADULTS ARE EVALUATED FOR PLACEMENT;

11(4)HOW COMMUNITIES ARE NOTIFIED BY THE POSSIBLE PLACEMENT12OF AT-RISK PLACEMENT/POPULATIONS IN STATE OR RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES;

13 (5) HOW THE STATE ASSESSES THE IMPACT OF PLACEMENT OF 14 FACILITIES ON THE COMMUNITY;

15 (6) HOW THE STATE DETERMINES THE APPROPRIATENESS OF 16 LOCATION FOR FACILITIES IN A COMMUNITY; AND

17 (7) HOW A CONTRACTOR IS CERTIFIED TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR 18 AT-RISK POPULATIONS.

19 (D) ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 30, 1999, THE DEPARTMENTS SHALL ISSUE A 20 FINAL REPORT ON THE STUDY, SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT 21 ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 October 1, 1998.

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
