16 17	(2) The informational meeting may be canceled if all persons who made timely written requests withdraw the requests prior to the meeting.
	(3) Unless the notice of application OR THE NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL contained a notice of the informational meeting, the Department shall publish notice of the informational meeting.
23	(d) (1) The Department may require the applicant to attend an informational meeting or public or contested case hearing and present information concerning the application FOR A PERMIT, OR THE APPLICATION FOR THE RENEWAL OF A PERMIT.
	(2) If the applicant fails to appear and present information after a request from the Department, the application FOR A PERMIT, OR THE APPLICATION FOR THE RENEWAL OF A PERMIT may be denied.
