SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

## Article 66B - Zoning and Planning

- 3 [(d) (1) In Carroll County, prior to any approval of a preliminary or final
- 4 subdivision plat, the commission shall require certification of the adequacy of public
- 5 facilities by the agencies having jurisdiction over public facilities in Carroll County
- 6 including, but not limited to, the following: schools, public water and sewerage
- 7 facilities, police protection, roads and traffic control devices, storm drain facilities,
- 8 emergency service facilities, health care facilities and solid waste disposal facilities.
- 9 (2) The commission may consider and may use the failure of any agency
- 10 or agencies to certify the adequacy of any public facility or facilities to serve a
- 11 proposed subdivision as a basis for disapproval of a preliminary or final subdivision
- 12 plat.]
- 13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 5.03(e) of
- 14 Article 66B Zoning and Planning of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered
- 15 to be Section(s) 5.03(d).
- 16 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 17 October 1, 1998.
