A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Teacher Education Scholarship Program

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Teacher Education Scholarship Program to be
- 4 awarded by the State Scholarship Administration to certain individuals based
- on certain criteria; establishing the criteria for receiving and maintaining a
- 6 Teacher Education Scholarship; providing for the repayment of the scholarship
- 7 under certain circumstances; and generally relating to a Teacher Education
- 8 Scholarship Program to be awarded by the State Scholarship Administration.
- 9 BY adding to

- 12 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 13 (1997 Replacement Volume and 1997 Supplement)
- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 Article - Education

17 18-708.

- 18 (A) THERE IS A TEACHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AWARDED
- 19 UNDER THIS SECTION BY THE ADMINISTRATION TO STUDENTS WHO PLEDGE TO
- 20 TEACH IN A PUBLIC ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOL IN ANY COUNTY WITH AN
- 21 OVERALL TEACHER RETENTION RATE OF 10% OR LESS UPON COMPLETION OF THEIR
- 22 TEACHER EDUCATION STUDIES.
- 23 (B) A RECIPIENT OF A TEACHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP UNDER THIS
- 24 SECTION SHALL:
- 25 (1) BE A RESIDENT OF THE STATE AT THE TIME THE SCHOLARSHIP IS
- 26 AWARDED;
- 27 (2) BE A GRADUATE OF AN ACCREDITED HIGH SCHOOL; AND

- 1 (3) SATISFY WHATEVER OTHER CRITERIA THE ADMINISTRATION AND 2 THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION ESTABLISH.
- 3 (C) A SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED UNDER THIS SECTION:
- 4 (1) MAY BE USED FOR THE TUITION AND MANDATORY FEES AT AN
- 5 ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY THAT HAS A PROGRAM OF UNDERGRADUATE
- 6 OR GRADUATE STUDIES THAT WOULD CERTIFY THE RECIPIENT TO TEACH IN THIS
- 7 STATE;
- 8 (2) MAY NOT EXCEED THE EQUIVALENT ANNUAL TUITION AND
- 9 MANDATORY FEES OF A FULL-TIME RESIDENT UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT AT THE
- 10 UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK; AND
- 11 (3) MAY BE HELD AS LONG AS THE RECIPIENT MAINTAINS A GRADE
- 12 POINT AVERAGE OF AT LEAST 2.5 ON A 4.0 SCALE OR ITS EQUIVALENT.
- 13 (D) EACH RECIPIENT OF A SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED UNDER THIS SECTION
- 14 MAY HOLD THE SCHOLARSHIP UNTIL COMPLETION OF A MASTER'S DEGREE IN
- 15 EDUCATION.
- 16 (E) FOLLOWING GRADUATION THE RECIPIENT OF A SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED
- 17 UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL TEACH IN A PUBLIC ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY
- 18 SCHOOL IN ANY COUNTY WITH AN OVERALL TEACHER RETENTION RATE OF 10% OR
- 19 LESS FOR A PERIOD OF AT LEAST 10 YEARS.
- 20 (F) (1) IF THE RECIPIENT OF A SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED UNDER THIS
- 21 SECTION DOES NOT TEACH IN A PUBLIC ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOL IN
- 22 ANY COUNTY WITH AN OVERALL TEACHER RETENTION RATE OF 10% OR LESS FOR 10
- 23 YEARS, THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED SHALL BE CONSIDERED A LOAN TO BE REPAID
- 24 TO THE STATE BASED ON REPAYMENT TERMS ESTABLISHED BY THE
- 25 ADMINISTRATION.
- 26 (2) IF THE RECIPIENT TEACHES IN A PUBLIC ELEMENTARY OR
- 27 SECONDARY SCHOOL IN ANY COUNTY WITH AN OVERALL TEACHER RETENTION RATE
- 28 OF 10% OR LESS FOR ONLY A PORTION OF THE 10 YEARS, THE STATE SHALL PRORATE
- 29 THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED TO REFLECT THE TIME THAT THE RECIPIENT TAUGHT
- 30 AND THE REMAINING PORTION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED SHALL BE
- 31 CONSIDERED A LOAN TO BE REPAID TO THE STATE BASED ON REPAYMENT TERMS
- 32 ESTABLISHED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.
- 33 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 34 July 1, 1998.
