BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 **Article - Education** 16 19-102. 17 (c) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (3) of this subsection, the aggregate 18 principal amount of bonds outstanding and the present value of capital lease 19 payments, less the amount of any reserve fund or sinking fund requirement 20 established for the bonds or capital leases, may not exceed, as of the date of issue of 21 the bonds, the following: 22 [\$647,304,260] \$750,000,000 for the University System of (i) 23 Maryland;

\$40,000,000 for Morgan State University;

\$25,000,000 for St. Mary's College of Maryland; and

\$15,000,000 for Baltimore City Community College.
